

DSA Consultation Paper

Service improvements, safety related measures & general fee increases

The Minister of State, Department for Transport (Dr. Stephen Ladyman): I have today published a Consultation Paper seeking views on a package of measures which propose changes to the way in which the Driving Standards Agency conducts its business to deliver a better service and improve the quality of the assessments they offer, and to ensure that the costs of the services provided are recovered in a fair and efficient manner.

The proposals are grouped into three areas:

- Service improvements
- Safety related measures
- General fee increases
