Mobile Solutions

Mobile working is now increasingly widespread across the public sector as organisations strive to increase efficiency and operate more flexibly. Consultancy Services

Business Solutions

This package covers the majority of generic telecoms areas, easily accessed online in a bespoke catalogue. It includes voice calls and lines, point-to-point circuits, infrastructure and connectivity, dark fibre, connectivity to the kerb, wireless data infrastructure, networking



equipment, ISP services, EGTPS, structured cabling maintenance, billing audit services and Geographic Information Services and Solutions (GISS).
